REQUIREMENT FOR TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FOR MINERAL EXPORT PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The Mining and Minerals Regulatory Authority (MMRA) wishes to inform all Mineral Export Permit applicants and stakeholders that, effective immediately, all Mineral Export Permit applications must be accompanied by a valid Tax Clearance Certificate (TCC) issued by the Malawi Revenue Authority for that specific export transaction. This requirement is in addition to the submission of proof of payment of mineral royalties.

Applicants are advised that once an Inspection Certificate has been issued and the relevant authorities have assessed the applicable mineral royalty, they are required to pay the assessed royalty to the Malawi Revenue Authority and thereafter apply for a Transactional royalty TCC.

This development is in accordance with the **Fifteenth Schedule - number 23, of the Taxation Act.**

The MMRA further wishes to inform all stakeholders that no application for a Mineral Export Permit will be processed without a valid Transactional royalty TCC issued by the Malawi Revenue Authority for the respective transaction.

MMRA appreciates the continued cooperation and compliance from all stakeholders in ensuring adherence to the applicable legal and regulatory requirements.


